The brief from the client was to supply a semi-permanent structure providing weather protection during filming of The Lion, The Witch & The Wardrobe, in the Southern Alps of New Zealand.

The high ceilings and clear span widths had to accommodate myriad set up options such as blue screens, wardrobes, lighting rigs, catering, and all other production requirements.

Capable of accommodating small theatrical to blockbuster Hollywood movie productions, the Alu-Span TFS is perfectly suited to support heavy audio, video, electrical and lighting systems.
